

Kate Wall - Gardening in a Subtropical Climate

Kate Wall was our guest speaker in May this year and is an expert gardener who owns and operates "The Gardener's Wall". Kate specializes in garden consultations and make overs, and can help with advice for best gardening results, or help you to create your own dream garden.

Kate is an expert on sub-tropical plants, knows how to care for them and how to create beautiful gardens. So much of our gardening information is written (or filmed) in climates which are not only much cooler than ours but have very different rainfall and humidity patterns. How does this information translate to our climate here in the balmy subtropics?

Kate will discuss ways to:

- * translate what we read,
- * help you to understand what a subtropical climate means for gardening, and


